NEW DOCUMENTARIES, LIVE STAGE ACTS & ART HOUSE CLASSICS THIS MONTH

Hello from your friendly neighbourhood cinema! As everyone preps for back-to-school and the impending fall season - not to mention the cooler weather - let us give you a few good reasons why you should just camp out at the Revue Cinema this month.

The launch of our new season of Special Events: Anthony Oliveira's **Dumpster Raccoon Film Series** continues September 15 with Brian De Palma's *Phantom of the Paradise* (1974) (preceded by a drag queen act by Heroine). **Anime! at the Revue** returns on September 20 with an exclusive 20th anniversary screening of Satoshi Kon's *Perfect Blue* (1997). **Designing the Movies** resumes September 27 with the Diana Ross vehicle *Mahogany* (1975), where host Nathalie Atkinson will be joined by Suzanne Boyd, editor-in-chief of Zoomer, to chat about Diana Ross, divas, and the racial politics of fashion. **Throwback Cinema** celebrates back-to-school with Danny Devito's classic *Matilda* (1996). **Silent Revue**, our longest-running series, launches its 10th season of year-long silent film programming on September 30 with F.W. Murnau's *Sunrise* (1927), featuring live accompaniment by the Ugly Beauties. Film festivals on Roncesvalles: You might be aware

of a pretty significant film festival taking place on King St. West over the next couple of weeks, but we're delighted to host a few other festivals in our own 236-seat cinema: the celebrated **Caribbean Tales Film Festival** (September 12-14), showcasing films that are dynamic in their uniquely Canadian view on the nature of black resilience, as well as the second edition of the **Toronto Motorcycle Film Festival** (August 28-30).

Free screenings and events: On September 15, the Roncesvalles Polish Festival presents a live stage act at the Revue, documenting the life of silent film star Pola Negri. Random House Canada welcomes the neighbourhood on September 17 for the launch of local best-selling author Kenneth Opel & illustrator Sydney Smith's new book, *Inkling*. Finally, on September 23, the Revue Cinema joins in on **Art House Theater Day**, celebrating the legacy of independent theatres as advocates for cinema arts. We present a free screening of Agnès Varda's *Cléo de 5 à 7*.

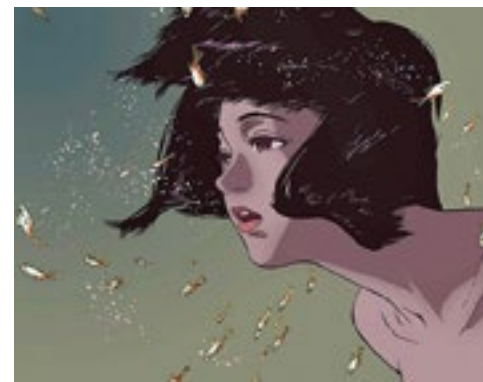

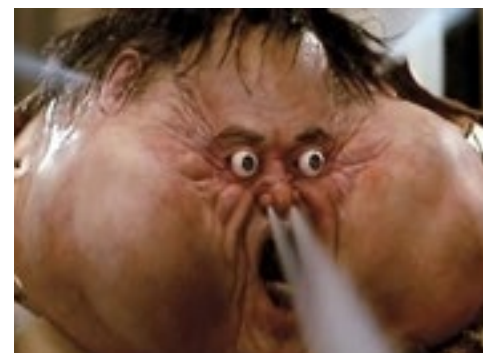

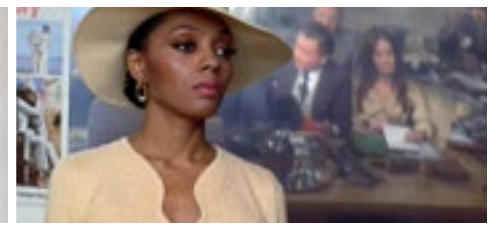
